TEE TIME POLICY

- * Weekday membership permits play Monday through Friday only (holidays after 1:00 pm.) – normal green fees apply on weekends. Note: All member events are normally held on weekends.
- λ Members may book tee times as follows:

Adult Members	Maximum eight days in advance
Intermediates	Maximum three days in advance
Juniors	Maximum one day in advance
- λ Intermediates can not book tee times before 1:00 p.m. Saturdays or 11:00 a.m. Sundays and Holidays – maximum two intermediates playing with two senior members before these times.
- λ Juniors can not tee off before 2:00 p.m. on weekends or holidays, or between 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. weekdays unless authorized by the pro shop.
- λ Tees will be closed where necessary to accommodate member events or outside tournaments.
